

# WHAT TO BRING CHECKLIST

## Breast Cancer Screening Guidelines & What To Bring Information About Your Upcoming Appointment

### **THIS SHEET IS FOR YOU TO HELP PREPARE FOR YOUR BREAST CANCER EDUCATION AND SUPPORT SERVICES.**

Please review the “What to Bring” list and gather any items you can. If you don’t have some documents, that is okay. **You will NOT be turned away.** Your Community Health Worker (CHW) will help you get any missing documents.

#### **PROOF OF IDENTITY (BRING ONE, IF AVAILABLE)**

Examples include:

- State ID
- Driver’s License
- Passport
- Hospital face sheet with photo
- Work ID
- Library card with photo

**If you do not have an ID, your CHW can help you. Ask about the “How to Get an ID” resource.**

#### **PROOF OF CURRENT ADDRESS (BRING ONE, IF AVAILABLE)**

Examples include:

- State ID or Driver’s License
- Passport
- Hospital face sheet
- Utility bill
- Farm property tax bill or deed
- Social Security statement
- Rent or mortgage bill
- Major credit card bill
- Mail from IDHS (WIC, SNAP, TANF, LIHEAP)

#### **TYPES OF INSURANCE**

- Private insurance
- Medicare
- Medicaid
- Employer insurance

**No insurance is acceptable**

#### **ACCEPTABLE FORMS INCLUDE ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:**

- Private Insurance Card (through job or purchased yourself)
- Medicare Card or ID #
- Medicaid Card or RIN #
- Managed Care Organization Card (Meridian, etc.) or ID
- Print-Out or Copy
- Document listing

**If you do NOT have insurance, your CHW can help check eligibility, enroll you or provide you with a referral.**

#### **IF YOU ARE CURRENTLY SEEING OTHER MEDICAL PROVIDERS**

Please bring or write down:

- Name of your provider
- Date you were last seen
- Clinic or hospital location
